\*\* The cost of regional training varies significantly. There is local variation as to how this is paid for. HEE TV does not top-slice the cost of regional training from trainee study budget (unlike many other deaneries) but for specialist courses, particularly franchised courses, trainees will have to pay for training events individually.

### **Subspecialty training**

There are four subspecialty programmes within O&G. The annual registration fee is £134, with an additional £176 for the first year. Subspecialty programmes can be either two or three years. Each of the four subspecialties requires attendance at mandatory courses.
