

TA7-Criteria for New Trainers to Request Approval

- 1. Complete TA8-Pre-approval visit form
- 2. Must have completed approved Educational Supervisors/GP Trainers' course from any UK Deanery.
- 3. Must have done at least three years as post CCT GP or two years post CCT GP if already in training practice.
- 4. Attend local Trainers' groups; need to attend at least 50% of meetings in observational and developmental capacity.
- 5. Attend Health Education England Thames Valley deanery Faculty Day (usually) held in March and October.
- Attend Work Place Based Assessment (WPBA) Nuts and Bolts course, there is one for CBD & COTs and one for ESR & Learning Logs. Expected to do at least WPBA CBD & COTs course before applying for an Approval Visit.
- 7. Write out an Educational Personal Development Plan.
- 8. Meet with local Programme Directors (PDs) who will look at pre-approval visit form and inform GP Admin if ready for Approval Visit.
- 9. This process could take six months to a year.
- 10. Once PDs have informed GP Admin then Approval Visit can be arranged.

Criteria for Existing Trainers to be assessed at Re-approval

- 1. Take part in a Training Practice Visit at least once every three years
- 2. Attend required number of Trainers' Meetings for the GP Training Scheme
- 3. "It would be exceptional for a Trainer not to attend two out of six Faculty Days" (i.e. two days over three years)
