

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR PSWS HELP?

- The PSWS is dedicated to helping doctors, dentists and pharmacists in training across the Thames Valley fulfill their career potential. We are a group of case managers and coaches who put trainee support and wellbeing at the heart of what we do.
- Our services include enhanced exam support, wellbeing services, personal coaching and mentoring to address career and performance improvement needs and workshops and information designed to support career choices.
- Established doctors, dentists and pharmacists can access coaching but will have to be self/employer funded

WHEN TO ACCESS THE PSW SERVICES

Trainee Services: Self Referral

Accessed Directly Through the PSWS:

- Coaching for wellbeing
- Career Dilemma
- Career Development
- Exam support (at any stage)- New from Jan 2021
- Online Yoga

Accessed Separately (not via PSWS):

- Trainees4Trainees peer support group
- Medic Support (confidential)

Educator Referral (with trainee consent!)

- Exam Support (after 2 unsuccessful attempts)
- Performance concerns that cannot be dealt with at local level and require escalation
 - These include, but are not limited to
 - concerns such as team working
 - communication
 - personal organisation challenges
 - professionalism and conduct concerns.

- Educators- Please make sure the trainee consent is documented



REFERRALS PROCESSES HAVE CHANGED

- Online referral forms for all services now (apart from SAT and Online Yoga)

- Removing need for CV's, ES reports, ARCP reports attached to referral forms
- Each and every referral will now get a one hour consultation with one of our case managers to work on a collaborative understanding of reason for contact
- (This will include an agreed summary of the meeting shared with the trainee, and stored confidentially on the PSWS database according to IG and GDPR guidelines)
- After this, the case manager will agree next steps with the trainee which can include signposting to services within and/or outside of PSWS.

EDUCATOR INVOLVEMENT

- If trainees refer themselves, there is usually no educator involvement unless
 - Coach and trainee agree this as part of ongoing work, with trainee consent
 - Educator has trainee consent to request this
- If educator has referred (with trainee consent) then
 - The case manager/coach will either correspond by introductory email or arrange an initial 3 way meeting
 - Followed by an email at midpoint inviting the educator's comment to further shape coaching conversations and
 - At closure to inform that the work has ended.
 - All this will be with the trainee's consent.

Feedback from trainers has commented specifically on the usefulness of the joint process in supporting the trainee to make progress.

Trainee feedback highlights need to keep stressing confidential nature of the work from the start- with caveats of personal and patient safety.

CAREERS SUPPORT

- We invite trainees to access coaching for career development at any stage of their training pathway
- We invite self referrals for career dilemmas
- Please note- if the dilemma exists in the context of performance concerns then the Educator must refer, with trainee consent)

EXAM SUPPORT

- Defined and Enhanced Exam Support service
- Trainees can self refer for support with exams at any stage
- 2 consecutive failed attempts at an exam <u>must prompt educator</u> <u>discussion</u> with trainee about referral to PSWS, with trainee consent
- All trainees will be offered screening for dyslexia as part of initial consultation meeting
- We are running Dyslexia Awareness Training sessions online for all educators (Jan-March 2021).

EXAM SUPPORT

Meet screening threshold for dyslexia

- Dyslexia assessment
- Report with recommendations for exam mitigation
- specialist coaching for any identified dyslexia profile

Do not meet screening threshold and/or other examrelated issues identified:

- a. Vocal Coaching
- b. Communications Coaching
- c. Managing Exam Anxiety (at any stage of training)
- d. Refining personal study skills for current context
- e. Signposting to other services



ARCP OUTCOMES AND THE PSWS- MYTHBUSTERS!



Educators and trainees will should be working together to identify if PSWS services or coaching would be beneficial, long before the ARCP.

No ARCP outcome necessitates a mandatory referral to the PSWS

BUT! Any outcome that is not a 1 or a 6 should prompt careful consideration of the issues and whether PSWS support could be helpful – call or email to discuss with us if unsure


Common past reasons for referral: Exam failure (especially multiple repeat failure);
Performance concerns related to work/life imbalance, or any conduct/professionalism issues.

Outcome 4 or Resignation from scheme: Self-referral for 3 sessions of coaching as part of ending the training contract

TRAINEES4TRAINEES

Being a doctor is inherently challenging and a space to reflect on our experiences is very important.

'Trainees4trainees' are trainee led peer support groups, designed by more senior trainees who wished we had similar support during our training. The sessions are for everyone, throughout training. In the groups we talk about general experiences in our jobs, and often through talking we all realise that we all feel the same way.

The groups are held regularly and facilitated to provide a safe environment for discussion. These sessions are currently held online.

Usually we try to allocate groups of similar trainees e.g. FY1s/ anaesthetists. HEE-TV REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE

- All doctors must be registered with their own GP
- HEE service through Cordell Health
- This service does not replace local employer OH service provision, nor the OH service provided by the GP single lead employer arrangement, which must be approached for advice the first instance.
- Access to Cordell Health will be for trainees out of training who require OH advice but are not currently employed by a named trust; and trainees who have longstanding physical and/or mental health conditions impacting on their training, not just their current work placement, with no OH service follow up across region
- Referral to the service will be by a senior educator (HOS) and, with trainee consent, the report will be
 released to them and local OH for implementation of recommendations.
