

# PHEM Courses

## Essential Courses

- **National IBTPHEM “Pre-Hospital Emergency Medicine Induction Course” (Phase 1).**

This is a 7-day residential course that is mandated by IBTPHEM for all new doctors starting training in PHEM. The focus of course is safety on scene and the course is run in conjunction with the Fire and Ambulance Services. The cost is currently £2500 per candidate which includes accommodation and food. Flyer attached.

For first year PHEM trainees.

- **National “PHEM Obstetrics & Neonatology Course”.**

This is a 1-day course run by IBTPHEM at Northampton General Hospital. The cost (last year) is £250.00 per candidate. The course is essential for trainees to acquire their competencies in prehospital obstetrics and neonatology. ## Desirable Courses

- **Cadaveric PHEM surgical skills course.**

- **Major Incident Medical Management and Support (MIMMS).**

A 2-day course focussing on the management of major incidents. Cost is typically £450.00.
