

## **Training Modules**

Prescribers Course	Amendments to the <u>Human Medicines Regulations 2012</u> , enable suitably trained dental hygienists and therapists to personally supply and administer specified medicines without requiring a patient specific direction from a dentist, or a patient group direction. The NHSE commissioned online training has been developed in partnership with NHSE WT&E. Training can be accessed on the <u>NHS</u> <u>Learning Hub</u> .
	The training launch follows on from the publication of the <u>guidance on</u> the supply and administration of medicines by dental hygienists and dental therapists, and the recently held <u>webinar</u> for contractors, dental hygienists and therapists.
